Gear should be rugged and functional. Layers of "moisture wicking" fibers (wool, polypro, polar Tec, fleece, Dacron) are essential in the mountains to stay warm and dry, as is a good two-piece set of raingear. All outer wear jackets, hats and helmets must be labeled with permanent marker or name labels.
