This list is essential to have for camp! Our priority for head cover is sun and rain protection and warmth, (i.e. cowboy hat). Gear should be rugged and functional. Layers of "moisture wicking" fibers (wool, polypro, polar Tec, fleece, Dacron) are essential in the mountains to stay warm and dry, as is a good two-piece set of raingear.

(Note - riding helmets will be provided if it is determined the rider should wear for safety reasons.)

All bedding and linens are provided, including a sleeping bag for the overnight campout.

NO food should be brought unless a medical/health requirement. Any required food will remain in the main lodge and stored securely in the kitchen. No food of any kind is allowed in the cabins at any time.

Arrival on the Sunday of the camp start should be between 3-6 pm. If a different time is needed, please advise as soon as possible to make arrangements to be met upon arrival at Triangle C by calling 361-449-6090 or 307-455-2225.
